I am the parent or legal guardian of the above named student (the "Student"). In consideration of the Student's participation in the following trip organized by The Urban School, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation (the "School"): France, scheduled for March 1 through March 16, 2019, including travel to and from such destination (collectively, the "Trip"), and as a condition thereof, I am signing this International Travel Liability Release (this "Release"). This Release is made in favor of the School and its trustees, officers, employees, and representatives (the School and all such persons are collectively referred to as the "Urban Released Parties"). My heirs, next of kin, distributees, guardians, devisees, conservators, executors, administrators, legal representatives, and assigns are collectively referred to as my "Survivors."

On behalf of myself, the Student and my Survivors, I acknowledge and agree as follows:

1. Acknowledgment of Risk; Voluntary Participation. The Student and I are aware and understand that participating in the Trip has inherent risks and that these risks cannot be eliminated, altered, or controlled regardless of the care used, the skill or experience possessed, or the precautions taken (in each case, if any) by me, the Student or anyone else, including the Urban Released Parties. The Student and I are aware of the risks involved with the Student's participation in the Trip. The Student and I are aware that international travel may entail risks including, but not limited to, the hazards of traveling in politically unstable areas, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism and war, and that there may be risks, hazards, delays and unanticipated events associated with foreign political, legal, social and economic conditions, language barriers, safety hazards and standards, search and/or seizure of property by customs or other governmental authorities, crime, inclement weather, natural disasters, standards of quality, hygiene, communicable diseases, insect-borne diseases, political stability, consumption of food and drink, sanitation facilities, cleanliness, telecommunication facilities, emergency medical evacuation, medical treatment or medical services. I understand and acknowledge that it is my responsibility to review any current travel advisories, warnings, precautions and immunization recommendations that may be applicable to the Trip, including, but not limited to, those issued by the U.S. Department of State, Bureau of Consular Affairs, the Centers for Disease Control and any other sources I deem pertinent.

The Student and I are aware that the Student's participation in the Trip may involve various modes of transportation (including air travel and ground transportation, including, but not limited to, by public bus, private bus, subway, train), recreational and sightseeing activities, indoor and outdoor educational activities, guided and unguided tours, bus tours, and homestays. A copy of the itinerary for the Trip is attached.

The Student and I understand that the Student's participation in the Trip may result in physical and/or psychological injury, including, but not limited to, serious, permanent bodily injury, paralysis, illness and/or death, and/or

damage to my, the Student's or others' belongings. The Student and I voluntarily elect, with knowledge of the risks involved, for the Student to participate in the Trip.

I further acknowledge that at times during the Trip the Student may be many hours from the nearest medical care or treatment, that available medical treatment may not equate with the level of care available in many U.S. hospitals, and that these conditions and the remoteness of some of the locations visited on the Trip may subject the Student to additional risks of injury, disease, death or damage to personal property; and, that any injuries or damage the Student does sustain may grow more severe or lead to the Student's premature death due to the remoteness of the location, the lack of quick access to quality medical care in some instances, and/or the poor quality of the roads or available transportation in some areas.

2. Assumption of Risk. The Student and I accept and assume any and all risks, damages, and hazards associated, directly or indirectly, with the Student's participation in the Trip, whether known or unknown, including the possibility of physical or psychological injury, illness, disability, death, property damage or other physical or financial loss arising therefrom of any nature whatsoever, whether foreseen or unforeseen (all such risks, damages, and hazards, whether sustained by me, the Student, the Urban Released Parties or others, including, but not limited to, those described in this Paragraph 2 and Paragraph 1 above, are collectively referred to as the "Risks and Losses"), whether caused by the action, inaction or active or passive negligence of me, the Student, any of the Urban Released Parties, any other third parties, or otherwise.

3. Liability Release. The Student and I release, forever discharge, and will hold harmless the Urban Released Parties, and each of them, from any and all claims, actions, demands, rights, causes of action, losses, liabilities, costs and expenses, including attorneys' fees (all such claims and liabilities are collectively referred to as the "Claims"), arising from or in connection with any of the Risks and Losses that may actually be sustained or suffered by me, the Student or by any other person (including any of my Survivors) as a direct or indirect consequence of the Student's participation in the Trip, whether caused by the action, inaction or active or passive negligence of me, the Student, any of the Urban Released Parties, any other third parties, or otherwise. The Student and I agree that I, the Student, and any of my Survivors may not make a claim against, sue, attach the property of, or demand compensation or indemnity from any of the Urban Released Parties in connection with any Claims and we hereby waive all such Claims.

4. Insurance. I understand that to participate in the Trip, the Student must be insured for medical and hospital expenses and hereby confirm that the Student is so insured. I further

acknowledge that such insurance is primary and non-contributory to any insurance that the School may carry.

5. Governing Law; Severability. This Release will be governed by and construed according to the laws of the State of California, without reference to principles of choice of law thereof. If any term or provision of this Release is determined to be illegal, unenforceable, or invalid in whole or in part for any reason, such illegal, unenforceable, or invalid provisions or part thereof will be stricken from this Release, and such provision will not affect the legality, enforceability, or validity of the remainder of this Release. If any provision or part thereof of this Release is stricken in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph, then the stricken provision will be replaced, to the extent possible, with a legal, enforceable, and valid provision that is as similar in tenor to the stricken provision as is legally possible. This Release will survive the completion of the Student's participation in the Trip and will continue in full force and effect thereafter.

I sign this Release with the full knowledge that the School assumes no responsibility for any Risks and Losses to me, the Student, my Survivors or to any third party as a result of the Student's participation in the Trip, and that the Student's participation in the Trip is conditioned upon my and the Student's acceptance of the full and complete responsibility for any such loss, damage, claim or liability.

I have read this Release carefully and fully understand all its terms and provisions. I have knowingly and voluntarily executed and delivered this Release understanding the risks to me and the Student and have done so of my own free will, without relying on any statement or representation of any of the Urban Released Parties. I understand that

this is the entire agreement between the undersigned and the Urban Released Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and that that this agreement cannot be modified or changed in any way by oral statements by any of the Urban Released Parties or by the Student or me. I understand that, in the event of any litigation against any of the Urban Released Parties, this Release may be raised as a defense and bar to, and as a waiver and release of, legal rights that might otherwise be asserted by me, the Student or by my Survivors.
